Warrior Arndt is a 'jack of all Warrior trades' for Whiskers



It's not every volunteer who can tackle a building project, then nurture the frailest of kittens back to health. But Jeremy Arndt of Prole can maneuver both with ease – along with countless other duties – earning him the title of Whiskers Warrior, Whiskers TNR's volunteer of the month.

"There is no task too big or small," said Nicole Rhodes of Norwalk, the nonprofit's volunteer coordinator. "Jeremy will figure out how to get things done."

But then, Arndt has a vested interest in the organization. His wife, Corissa, founded Whiskers TNR in 2016, helping more than 2,000 cats and kittens in the time since. Since intakes were done in the Arndts' own home initially – and now at their holding facility – it's no

stretch to say that Arndt has had a hand in tending to nearly them all.

"I do it to help Corissa out in any way possible to spread out the workload, mostly caring for the cats that are being held in the building," he said. "I feel very proud of the things that Corissa and I have learned through the process."

And, according to Rhodes, Arndt should be proud of what he's personally added to Whiskers. She described him as a jack of all trades whose "patience, tenacity, quick thinking and logic all play a critical role in our success." For instance, Rhodes, who also serves as a foster for Whiskers, remembers when Arndt saved the day when a "very spicy" kitten needed to be given a pill for medication.

"He and Corissa came over to the house, and he handled the situation like a champ, even if it required a few bandages after the fact!" she said. "I have also watched him tenderly care for kittens on the brink of death as he nurtured them back to health."

Arndt's day job also requires plenty of attention to detail. For the past 24 years, he has worked for the Iowa DNR Air Quality Bureau, serving as one of two leaders for the section that oversees operating permits for the 280 or so largest emitting facilities in the state.

When not busy working or volunteering, Arndt enjoys golfing, tending to the other animals on his and Corissa's farm, and his latest hobby: backyard BBQ and smoking meat. But if a Whiskers situation pops up? Arndt springs into action, according to Rhodes, with the strong work ethic and critical thinking skills that are his trademark – along with the way that he supports his wife.

"Thank you so much for being Corissa's rock. I know without the love and support that you give her each and every day, Whiskers would not be what it is today. She carries a heavy burden to keep this passion of hers alive, but so do you. The whole team is eternally grateful for your support to our mission."
